1 in 3 pets Go Missing

A dog microchip or cat microchip can help your lost pet return home safely and quickly.

What is a Microchip

A HomeAgain microchip is your pet's permanent ID. A pet microchip is the size of a grain of rice and goes beneath your pet's skin. This permanent ID can never be removed or become impossible to read. HomeAgain uses this ID to contact you and reunite you with your pet.

The Pet Recovery Process

Should your microchipped pet get lost, the HomeAgain recovery system can go into action and give your pet the best chance of coming back home to you.

1 in 3 pets will get lost.

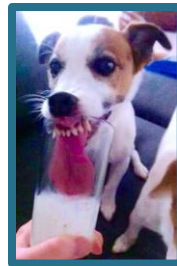
